False Creek Women's Regatta Safety Protocols:

An addendum for any special events will be created and posted during the event. Safety protocols for the event will be adjusted from time to time in response to active Provincial Health Orders, and visitors and participants should expect that measures may change with little or no notice.

- Anyone feeling unwell, waiting for COVID test results, required to self-isolate, or testing
 positive for COVID-19 are required to stay home. Racers with close contact to a
 confirmed COVID cases on their team are asked to consult a doctor in regards to
 self-isolation requirements.
- Masks are highly recommended at all times, and should only be taken off when eating or drinking, or if they are in a private area with their team.
- Hand sanitizer and masks will be provided around our event sites for anyone that requires some.
- Visitors should avoid congregating in large groups. Volunteers will ask visitors in high traffic zones especially around the Main Stage, lineups, pavilions, and other areas to space themselves out.
- Chairs and tables are positioned to help visitors safely enjoy the Festival. Please do not move any chairs or tables from their original positions.
- Festival personnel will monitor the site to ensure visitor capacity is not exceeded.
- Proof of vaccination or medical exemption is required for indoor venues as indicated.
